Improving the quality of life for vulnerable people by promoting and developing integration and community development measures in social, economic, educational and cultural fields


To fulfill its goal, the association aims to achieve the following

- Social integration and support young people belonging to underprivileged social categories;

1. THEY WILL NEVER FORGET!



"Medical and psycho-social care, individual humanitarian aid and PR work for 30 survivors of the genocide of the Roma in Romania"

Project duration: 15.03.2018 - 31.09.2019



PROGRAMME

The purpose

of this project was to improve health and social conditions for 30 survivors of Roma Genocide from Ialomiţa and Giurgiu Counties, providing them support services and contributing to their societal recognition as a victim of Holocaust.



The objectives of the project:

- 30 survivors of the genocide of the Roma receive access to medical services and aids (hearing aids, glasses etc.) and are looked after. They are given hygiene products and food vouchers and are thus able to pay better attention to their diet and hygiene.
- The beneficiaries participate actively in social life and festivities and thus experience support from the community. Loneliness is eliminated.
- The beneficiaries profit from practical support in everyday life (work and minor repairs in house and garden, assistance with visits to public authorities, shopping, distribution of meals) through the involvement of 10 young Roma volunteers.
- The survivors are recognized as victims of National Socialism by their community and the local authorities. They can tell the younger generation and the Roma community about their lives. Spreading their histories of persecution (video, web-site) promotes understanding of their present needs.

Activities developed during the project

Through projects' activities, we improved the survivors' every day life, their physical, emotional and social conditions, ensuring their access to quality health care services, providing them medical aids, food tickets, toiletries. Also we promoted an inter-generational dialogue and 10 young Roma volunteers were involved in providing moral and concrete support for the survivors.

> Together with community nurses we periodically monitored their health status but also we identified some of their health problems. That is why during the project we provided them a number of: 18 canes, 5 hearing devices, 6 blood pressure cuffs, 1 walking frame.









DEVELOPED ACTIVITIES IN 2019

> For a better attention to their diet and their hygiene, we monthly procured and distributed them food tickets and toiletries.





> 10 volunteers were involved in offering help to the survivors in domestic work, accompanying them where they wanted to go (doctor, shopping, city hall). Also they were preparing and serving their meal and in the winter they take care of heating their room.





DEVELOPED ACTIVITIES IN 2019

We promoted the intergenerational dialogue. In July, August and September 2019 we organized meetings in Feteşti, Bolintin-Vale and Andrășeşti communities and we involved the volunteers and the survivors to tell them about the Holocaust.





In partnership with Cultural and Social Research Center "Romane Rodimata" we elaborated video movie with survivors testimonies. We promoted the movie with persecution histories in every community and also to the final conference.





> We organized the final conference on the 21st of September 2019 at the School Inspectorate in Slobozia, Ialomița county.






With this project we managed to make known a part of the history of the Roma Holocaust, both in the communities where we implemented the project and in cities such as Bucharest or Slobozia. Also the fact that photos of our beneficiaries and the interviews they gave were presented to the August 2, 2019, Roma Holocaust Exhibition from Auschwitz-Birkenau and Bucharest, make us think that our work became more visible in a wider community.

2. "PROMOTING THE TRADITIONS OF ROMA FROM HÂRŞOVA CITY"



In August, 2019 our project "Promoting the traditions of Roma from Harsova City" has been chosen by the Open Danube Jury as one of the five winner project of the "Open Danube Award 2019".

The aim of the project:
Increasing the awareness about the low interest in preserving the cultural values of Roma people.

Project duration: 05.09.2019 to 15.12.2019

The objective:

To improve the perception of the majority population from SE of Romania, towards the Romani culture in particular and Roma population in general.



- > On the 15th of September 2019 we signed the partnerships agreement with Hârşova City Hall Hârşova Cultural House and the Secondary School no. 1 from Hârşova.
- With the support of school mediator and dance instructor, until the 15th of October, there were selected 15 children of the Secondary School no. 1 from Hârşova City, aged between 9 and 14.





We made the acquisition of the traditional costumes.


> There were organised rehearsals of the dance band.




> We delivered to Harsova Cultural House the 15 traditional roma costumes on a bailment agreement, to used them in their performances in order to promote Roma traditions.
