OUR MISSION



Improving the quality of life for vulnerable people by promoting and developing integration and community development measures in social, economic, educational and cultural fields.

To fulfill its goal, the association aims to achieve the following Objective and to develop the following activities



- Improving the standard of living of Roma through promoting of cultural and social policy, mobilization and involvement of Roma communities in decision-making.
- A sustainable community development in socio-cultural and economic field through involvement and increasing specific community resources and attracting resources from other levels;
- To promote, support, implementation and coordination of activities that contribute to the defense of human rights, civil rights (including minorities) and children's rights;
- The protection of individuals and families in a state of social risk by providing advice or free counseling in relationship with authorities and state institutions, information activities about the rights, facilitation, training, integration into diverse funding programs;
- Social integration and support young people belonging to underprivileged social categories;
- Human resource development in vulnerable groups;

Developed projects in 2016

The end of 2015 came with a good news for ADIS Muntenia: one of the three grant applications submitted has been approved by the Civic Innovation Fund. The financing contract for the project „ I get involved, I win !" was signed on the 18 th of December 2015.

The project was realized with financial support of the Fund for Civic Innovation, a program developed by the Civil Society Development Foundation in partnership with the Romanian-American Foundation and Trust for Civil Society in Central and Eastern Europe.

I GET INVOLVED, I WIN!

Implementation period 01/04/2016 – 08/31/2016

The aim of the project :

- to involve young Roma people from Fetesti in socio economic development of the communities to which they belong, through active participation and civic responsibility

Direct beneficiaries - 15 young Roma aged between 18-35 years who wanted to be actively involved in their community life. They were trained in the field of civic involvement, they acquired communication skills and in the future they will be able to develop their own models and proposals for campaigns making people responsible for their communities.

Indirect beneficiaries - 1,500 members of Roma communities who benefited from awareness campaign and due to the activities of the 15 young people, they could make their problems known. Also through the activity of participation at the local council meetings, Roma people were better represented in relation to public authority.

Objectives of the project :

1. 15 young Roma from the three Roma communities of Fetesti will be trained in a Civic mobilization and Rights and Obligations of citizens .
2. Involving the 15 young Roma in the promotion of voluntary and civic responsibility activities by carrying out an awareness campaign on civic involvement and citizens' rights and obligations and a donation campaign which aims to stimulate social solidarity and to train citizens in charities
3. Developing the local public authority - roma community relationship through active involvement of young Roma in activities that regards their participation in decision making.



Implemented activities

ORGANIZING TRAINING SESSIONS TO PREPARE YOUNG CITIZENS IN EXERCISING THEIR RIGHTS, RESPONSIBILITIES AND PROMOTING CIVIC PARTICIPATION BEHAVIOR AMONG YOUNG ROMA.

Thus 15 young Roma from the three Roma communities of Fetesti (communities that do not relate to each other) were trained in a Civic mobilization and Rights and Obligations of citizens training. The training took place in 26nd / 27th of March 2016. The purpose of this training was to inform them about how they can get involve in civic mobilization and to become community resource persons.



***ORGANIZING A CAMPAIGN OF AWARENESS OF CITIZENS OF
THE THREE COMMUNITIES ON CIVIC ENGAGEMENT,
CITIZENSHIP RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS.***

Between 20 – 30 of April the young volunteers were actively involved in civic responsibility activities by carrying out an awareness campaign on civic involvement and citizens` rights and obligations.

The door to door campaign was developed in all three Roma communities from Fetesti.

There were informed 1500 people and there were distributed 1500 flyers.

ORGANIZING AND CONDUCTING A CAMPAIGN OF DONATIONS OF MATERIAL RESOURCES (CLOTHES, SHOES, SCHOOL SUPPLIES)

The campaign was carried out between 1 to 15 June 2016 in partnership with the Technological High School of Food Industry, Anghel Saligny Technological High School, Carol I Theoretical High School, Fetesti Municipality and Orion Radio Station. The purpose of the campaign was collecting clothes, shoes and school supplies for students from low-income families from Fetesti.

Over 500 kg donations were collected and after there were sorted and packed in cartons with our volunteers then there were redistributed to a total of 25 families. Also, some of these donations were given to the Organization for Children and Adults with special needs – Trebuie.



THE PARTICIPATION OF 15 YOUNG ROMA BY DELEGATION AT THE ORDINARY MEETINGS OF THE FETESTI LOCAL COUNCIL .

From March to July period the 15 volunteers with representatives of ADIS Muntenia participated at Fetesti City Council monthly meetings.

The purpose of this activity was that volunteers understand the modality of decision-making at a Local level and transmitting information and issues discussed at the meeting, to the communities to which they belong.



ORGANIZING MONTHLY MEETINGS WITH VOLUNTEERS TO IDENTIFY PROBLEMS THAT ROMA COMMUNITIES FACE.

From March to August the 15 young volunteers had 6 monthly meetings and they discussed trying to identify the problems of their communities and the solutions.

A result of these meetings was the Needs analysis of the Roma communities from Fetesti, that was submitted to the local council.



ORGANIZING A TRIP FOR 15 YOUNG ROMA WHO WERE INVOLVED IN THE PROJECT ACTIVITIES

By organizing this trip between 30-31st of July to Sinaia, Cota 1400, we met our purpose to recognize volunteers' efforts but also to motivate them to get involved in future civic actions in the communities they come from. And this was seen in their willingness to participate in other future similar actions.

A result of this activity was the post-implementation sustainability plan where the volunteers included the next activities they want to develop.
